

IYM 2019 INFORMATION

The High School is situated in Zion Road, Dublin 6. Travelling on the M50 exit at Junction 11. A map and instructions are available from the office.

Public Transport: The following bus routes, will get you there:

15 – via Connolly Station and Eden Quay to Rathgar village (10 minute walk to High School)

15B – every 20 min from Ringsend via Pearse St, & Sth Great Georges St to Zion Road/Bushy Park Road.

14 – every 15 – 20 minutes from Beaumont via Connolly Station and D'Olier Street, to Orwell Road, Rathgar.

16 – every 12 – 15 minutes from Dublin Airport via O'Connell St, to Rathfarnham Rd/Bushy Park Road (10 minute walk)

17 – from Blackrock to Rialto via Rathfarnham Road – alight at either War Memorial Hall (from Blackrock direction) or Rathdown Park (from Rialto direction) and walk up Bush Park Road (10 minute walk)

65 – from Poolbeg Street via Sth Great Georges St, Rathmines, and out to Tallaght and Blessington. Alight in Rathgar to get to High School. (10 minute walk) This bus is only every 1 or 2 hours but may help Friends staying in Tallaght.

Travelling by train to either Connolly or Heuston – take the Luas to Abbey Street, walk around the corner into O'Connell Street where you can get a 16 bus to Rathdown Park (10 minute walk to Zion Road)

Accommodation:

Both of these hotels are the closest to The High School and are convenient to public transport (15B,14,15). Bookings can be made via their website.
